The Campus Day registration site is located on the first floor of Rackham Auditorium at 915 E. Washington Street. Please dress casually and wear comfortable shoes for walking. Average winter temperatures in Ann Arbor range from 23°–48° F, so dress appropriately for the weather as you will be walking outdoors.

Campus Day parking is available in the public parking structure on Maynard Street, between William Street and Liberty Street, a short distance from Rackham Auditorium. Validation of up to eight hours is available on the day of your visit, but only in the Maynard Parking Structure (324 Maynard Street). Please bring your parking stub to Rackham Auditorium at the time of check-in to receive a validation stamp. Additional time beyond eight hours will be charged at the normal rate of \$1.20/hour. The University of Michigan is not responsible for parking tickets incurred on campus or in Ann Arbor for parking violations.
