



It's always best to check with your program coordinator for a specific list of what to bring. But, here are a few ideas to get you started:

### Bedding and personal items

Check to see if you'll need a sleeping bag or twin extra long sheets, blanket, and pillows.

You'll also want to pack several personal toiletry items, including:

- A towel and washcloth
- A plastic cup
- Soap
- Deodorant
- A toothbrush and toothpaste
- Lip balm
- Any medications you will need

### Clothes and gear for summer weather

Remember that summer in Michigan usually means hot, sometimes muggy weather. We recommend that you pack accordingly, including:

- Clothes for hot weather
- Walking shoes or sandals
- Rain gear
- A hat
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- An electric fan (many residence hall rooms are not air-conditioned)

### Miscellaneous

Here are a few other items you might want to bring for your time at the University of Michigan:

- An alarm clock
- A camera
- Insect repellent
- Drinks or snacks

### What not to bring

Leave your valuables at home. Examples include:

- Electronics  
*Stereos, CD players, video games, televisions*
- Expensive jewelry
- Excessive money
- Contact your program director or coach regarding cell phones
